Henry Derozio started the idea of composing English poems on Indian themes; the famed Dutts including Michael Madhusudan Dutt, Govind Chandra Dutt and his brothers, and Toru Dutt, offered it the

much-needed impetus and direction: and the succeeding poets like R.N Tagore, Manmohan Ghosh, Aurobindo, Sarojini Naidu, Harindranath Sri Chattopadhyay etc. provided it with strength and diversity. India's independence in 1947 marked a break with the past poetic practice and ushered in a new era of socio-political consciousness and religiocultural awakening. It set in a 'new' trend of poetical composition suffused with thematic variety, technical innovations, national and cultural instincts. Such contemporary poets as Nissim Ezekiel, P.Lal, A.K. Ramanujan, Kamala Das, Jayanta Mahapatra, Dom Moraes, Keshav Malik, Keki N.Daruwalla and Pritish Nandy, to name only a few, contributed substantially to the furtherance of 'new' Indian English Poetry.

All cotemporary Indian English poetry is sustained by the living waters of our racial tradition- deeply rooted in the Vedas, the Upanishads and the two great epics-The Ramayana and The Mahabharata. Poetry, being the most compact and complex form of art, is the best means of giving form and utterance to the hopes and despairs, the enthusiasm and apathy and the sense of oy and pain in the history of a nation. Contemporary Indian English poetry shows the re-assertion of the national genius and the emergence of a new spirit. self-confident and deeply rooted in the national tradition- so dynamic and modern. The spirit of poetry is as ancient the Vedas and as modern as the latest guided missile. Indian English poetry has now also drawn the scholarly and critical attention in almost all Indian and foreign university.

Indian English poetry has a unique role to derive from and to promote Indian spirit and consciousness and racial sensibility throughout the world. 
